PLAYING RULES

- 1) Match start time **8.00 P.M.**
- 2) A 'team' should consist of a minimum of six players and a maximum of 12 players at any one time.
- 3) Players can only play 1 frame in each session.
- 4) Six singles followed by six singles.
- 5) All players must register their names and sign on the registration form (winter season only).
- 5a) Summer season you are registered to a team when you sign the first result card (no transferring)
- 6) Registration forms must be handed in with your second result card to Fixture & Results Secretary. A marked box on the cards must be initialled by the team captain (with the teams' initials).
- 7) No player is allowed to register with any team after half way through the season unless approved by the committee with a 48-hours signing on period in place. There will be no players' transfer between teams allowed after half way through the season. All transfers must be applied via the Fixture & Results Secretary.
- 8) Three points are awarded to the winning team, one point to the drawing teams.
- 9) In event of a tie at the end of the season, legs won will decide the winner. If still level, a play-off will take place at a mutual venue to conclude the result
- 10) **Changes to World Rules - Playing rules** If all balls have been deemed to stop and the oncoming player has addressed the table, any ball on the edge of a pocket that falls in is replaced over the same pocket and no penalty to the player at the table.
- 11) **Renegade playing rules** All captains should complete their result cards as usual. Once the cards are exchanged, the home team captain should toss a coin to decide the turn of breaks. Toss of coin should also take place in the second half of the match.

- 12) **Presentation night.** Any winning teams should have a minimum of three players to attend the presentation night to collect their trophies.
- 13) **Loss of Deposit to food.** Any matches that are cancelled without the required 24 hour notice will lose their deposit money.
- 14) **Problem solving.** Any problems on the match nights, please contact the Leagues' referees, who will endeavour to provide prompt suitable solution.
